## Discussion Questions

### Before You Begin:

Pray asking God to help you see and hear His word rightly and ask Him to reveal himself to you as we conclude our study of the book of Ruth this week.

Let's end our study by reading through **the Book of Ruth, Chapters 1- 4** one more time. Reflect upon what God has revealed to you the past couple months and consider the discussion questions below.

1. In review, the qualifications of a kinsman-redeemer were:

- He had to be a close blood relative.
- He must be able to redeem and pay the redemption price.
- He must be willing to redeem.

Throughout our study of the Book of Ruth we saw Boaz fulfill these qualifications as Ruth and Naomi's kinsman-redeemer. We also have seen the picture that Boaz provided of our kinsman-redeemer, Jesus Christ. Let's read about the best part of this story – Jesus and His love for us!
